MEMORANDUM TO: Imperial Deputies of the Oasis

SUBJECT: **Mandatory Wear of Registration Badges at 117th Annual Session of the Imperial Council and
99th Annual Session of the Imperial Court, August 13-19, 2010**

1. This communication is to officially inform you that the Imperial Potentate and Imperial Divan have decreed that nobles and daughters as well as associate registrants attending the 117th and 99th Annual Sessions of the Imperial Council/Imperial Court in Tampa, Florida must wear their registration badges when attending all activities during the convention, to include entering the Exhibit Area. The Imperial Marshals have been directed by their Imperial Administrator to be observant in checking for Registration Badges. If conventioners forget and leave their badges at home they may report to the Convention Department Office located in the Tampa Convention Center, Room 30A, 4th Floor and obtain a replacement badge for a fee of \$15.00. The youth that are registered for the convention must wear their badges as well.


2. **WITH REGARDS TO PERSONAL CHECKS – NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR ON SIGHT REGISTRATION OR FOR PURCHASING SUPPLIES FROM THE IMPERIAL RECORDER'S OFFICE.**

If you have a recall/notification process in place under your Group Supervision Department, please have this information disseminated through this mechanism as well. This way the word will get to those nobles who are planning to attend the convention that may miss the July 2010 temple meeting. Once again, the bottom line is: **NO PERSONAL CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED, ONLY CASH OR POSTAL MONEY ORDERS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
